OAKWOOD STABLES EQUESTRIAN VISITORS - TERMS AND CONDITIONS

We want all visitors to enjoy their stay with us safely. In order for everyone to understand what is expected, acceptable and for the benefit of all, the following rules will apply:

On departure, loose boxes must be left in a clean and tidy condition, or a fee of £25 will be charged. If you would like to pre-arrange for your box to be cleaned for you, please let us know in advance.

When mucking out, do not overfill barrows, and please ensure that any loose bedding does not soil the stable yard, or the general area around. Please clear up any muck, or mud left by your horse in the stable yard.

Please do not waste water as we are on a meter. Do not use the hosepipe unless you are bathing your horse, or treating a wound. If you are just cooling your horse down after a ride, please use a bucket of water and sponge.

Every effort is made to check that our grazing paddocks are clear of any potential risks and hazards to your horse, but it is the horse owner's responsibility to check grazing areas are safe, before turning their horse out.

Tack and possessions are left in the tack room, or on the premises at the owner's risk.

The Owner will not accept any liability or responsibility for loss or injury to horses, items of tack, personal belongings of the Hirer, or the Hirer's trailer or lorry. It is the responsibility of the Hirer to arrange appropriate insurance in respect of all these items.

The Owner is responsible for their horses actions at all times, and any injury caused to themselves or others, or to Grange Farm property. Any accidents or damage will be notified immediately to the owners of Grange Farm, and paid for before departure.

Worming is very important for the health of all horses that use the yard, and for the welfare of our fields, so horses must be wormed prior to arrival (ideally 24 hours before) in order to take advantage of turning out your horse during your stay.

Horses must be fully insured, and have a passport. Please bring passport with vaccination certificate with you. All horses must be vaccinated as a minimum against Flu and Tetanus.

Children under the age of 16 must be supervised at all times. Please do not bring dogs into the stable yard.

Please do not play radios in the vicinity of the stable yard, and particularly if leaving early or late, please be careful not to cause a nuisance to other quests in the cottages.
